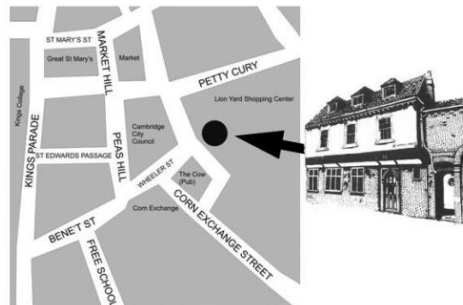

To enable your Cam Card to give you access to the Fisher Room and Library, please register with Fisher House through the Chaplaincy's website.

The Chapel of St John Fisher is the heart of the Chaplaincy. It is open all day.

The Fisher Room and its kitchen provide a social space for undergraduates and graduates to meet and relax during the day, with free tea and coffee.

The Fisher House Library has an extensive collection of books of history, literature, scriptural study, spirituality, and theology. It is a great place to study.
