## Gift Aid

If you allow your donations to be treated as Gift Aid donations, CUCA can claim 25p off the government for every £1 you donate.

In order for this to apply, you must be a UK taxpayer. The amount of tax reclaimed in each tax year by *all* the charities you support must not exceed the amount you pay in Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax in that year. Other forms of tax, such as Council Tax and VAT, do not count.

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you may be eligible to reclaim additional tax relief on your donations. To do this, you will need to list your Gift Aid donations on your tax return.
